Chesterfield County Government Announces Operational Changes

Chesterfield, SC – Based on DHEC’s data, Chesterfield County’s COVID-19 positive case counts peaked in mid-January and have steadily declined over the last several weeks. As a result of this sustained positive trend, Chesterfield County Government will lift previous restrictions on a number of services and return to normal hours of operation at most county facilities.

Beginning **March 15th**, the Administration Building will return to normal business hours and be open to the public 8:30 am – 5:00 pm, Monday – Friday. The building will be accessible from the Main Entrance on Mill Street with facial coverings/mask requirements and social distancing protocols remaining in place. For citizen and employee safety, departments will continue to limit the number of customers in their office areas.

Treasurer’s Office: On March 15th the Treasurer’s Office returns to regular business hours, 8:30 am – 5:00 pm, Monday – Friday. Citizens are encouraged to utilize our on-line taxpayer services. Pay online at www.chesterfieldcountysc.com or call 1-866-543-2615. Citizens are reminded they may utilize the secure 24-hour drop box located near the Drive Thru.

Court System: In accordance with the order of the Chief Justice of the South Carolina Supreme Court, Circuit, Family, Probate and Special Referee Courts may begin holding in-person proceedings, other than jury trials, beginning March 15th. Circuit Courts statewide may begin holding jury trials on April 5th, 2021.

Magistrate’s Court: In accordance with the order of the Chief Justice of the South Carolina Supreme Court, Magistrate Court in person hearings, with the exception of jury trials, will resume the week of March 15th.

Library: Beginning March 15th, the Library will open to the public from 8:30 am – 5:00 pm, Monday – Friday with restrictions on the number of patrons in the facilities at any one time. Facial coverings/mask requirements and social distancing remain in place. Residents are encouraged to utilize the library’s online resources.

FEES: Fees that had previously been waived will be reinstated effective March 15th in the offices of the Treasurer and Building Codes, and effective April 1st in the office of the Register of Deeds.
