#### 19. EXECUTIVE SESSION

- a. Pursuant to S.C. Code § 30-4-70(a)(2), Council may enter into executive session for the discussion of negotiations incident to proposed contractual arrangements, the receipt of legal advice where the legal advice relates to a pending, threatened, or potential claim or other matters covered by the attorney-client privilege, regarding the following:
  - i. American Rescue Plan Act
  - ii. Bid Award (2 dump trucks and roll off truck)
  - iii. Judicial Center Roof Bid Award
- b. Pursuant to S.C. Code § 30-4-70(a)(5), Council may enter into executive session for the discussion of matters relating to the proposed location, expansion, or the provision of services encouraging location or expansion of industries or other businesses in the area served by the county regarding the following: Project Flair.
- c. Pursuant to S.C. Code § 30-4-70(a)(1), Council may enter into executive session for the discussion of employment, appointment, compensation, promotion, demotion, discipline, or release of employees.
