 - i. Project Model (Designer Construction Corporation)
 - ii. Chesterfield County Economic Development Board
- b. Pursuant to S.C. Code § 30-4-70(a)(2), Council may enter into executive session for the discussion of negotiations incident to proposed contractual arrangements, the receipt of legal advice where the legal advice relates to a pending, threatened, or potential claim or other matters covered by the attorney-client privilege, regarding the following:
 - i. Condemnation of property for fire service
 - ii. Road Maintenance Fee
 - iii. Mobile Home Park Ordinance
 - iv. American Rescue Plan Act Final Rule for the State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF)
