CALL TO ORDER AND PRAYER

Chairman Rhett Butler welcomed everyone and Council Member Bruce E. Rivers opened the meeting with prayer.

ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Council Member Curtis made a motion to adopt the September 18, 2023 meeting agenda. Council Member Burns seconded the motion. Voting in favor of the motion was unanimous. Motion passed.

ORDINANCE READINGS AND RESOLUTIONS

a. <u>Emergency Ordinance Granting Temporary Easement to Town of Pageland – Lynches River Industrial Park</u>

Council Member Conklin made a motion to adopt the Emergency Ordinance. Council Member Burns seconded the motion. Voting in favor of the motion was unanimous. Motion passed.

b. Ordinance Granting Temporary Easement to Town of Pageland - Lynches River Industrial Park-1st Reading, by title only

Council Member Miller made a motion to pass 1st Reading, <u>by title only</u>. Council Member Rivers seconded the motion. Voting in favor of the motion was unanimous. Motion passed.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Council Member Foard seconded the motion. Voting in favor of the motion was unanimous. Motion passed.
