- a. Pursuant to S.C. Code § 30-4-70(a)(5), Council may enter into executive Session for the discussion of matters relating to the proposed location, expansion, or the provision of services encouraging location expansion of industries or other businesses in the area served by the county regarding the following: solar projects.
- **b.** Pursuant to S.C. Code § 30-4-70(a)(2), Council may enter into executive session for the discussion of negotiations incident to proposed contractual arrangements, the receipt of legal advice where the legal advice relates to a pending, threatened, or potential claim or other matters covered by the attorney-client privilege, regarding the following:
 - i. Condemnations County Line Road
 - ii. County Municipality Contract for Judicial Services
- c. Pursuant to S.C. Code § 30-4-70(a)(1), Council may enter into executive session for discussion of employment, appointment, compensation, promotion, demotion, discipline, or release of an employees.
