Code § 30-4-70(a)(2), Council may enter into executive session for the discussion of negotiations incident to proposed contractual arrangements, the receipt of legal advice where the legal advice relates to a pending, threatened, or potential claim or other matters covered by the attorney-client privilege, regarding the following:
 - i. Potential purchase of Property I
 - ii. Potential purchase of Property A
 - iii. Potential sale of Property L
- c. Pursuant to S.C. Code §§ 30-4-70(a)(1) and 30-4-40(a)(13), the Committee may enter into executive session for discussion of employment, appointment, compensation, promotion, demotion, discipline, or release of employees including the County Administrator.
